

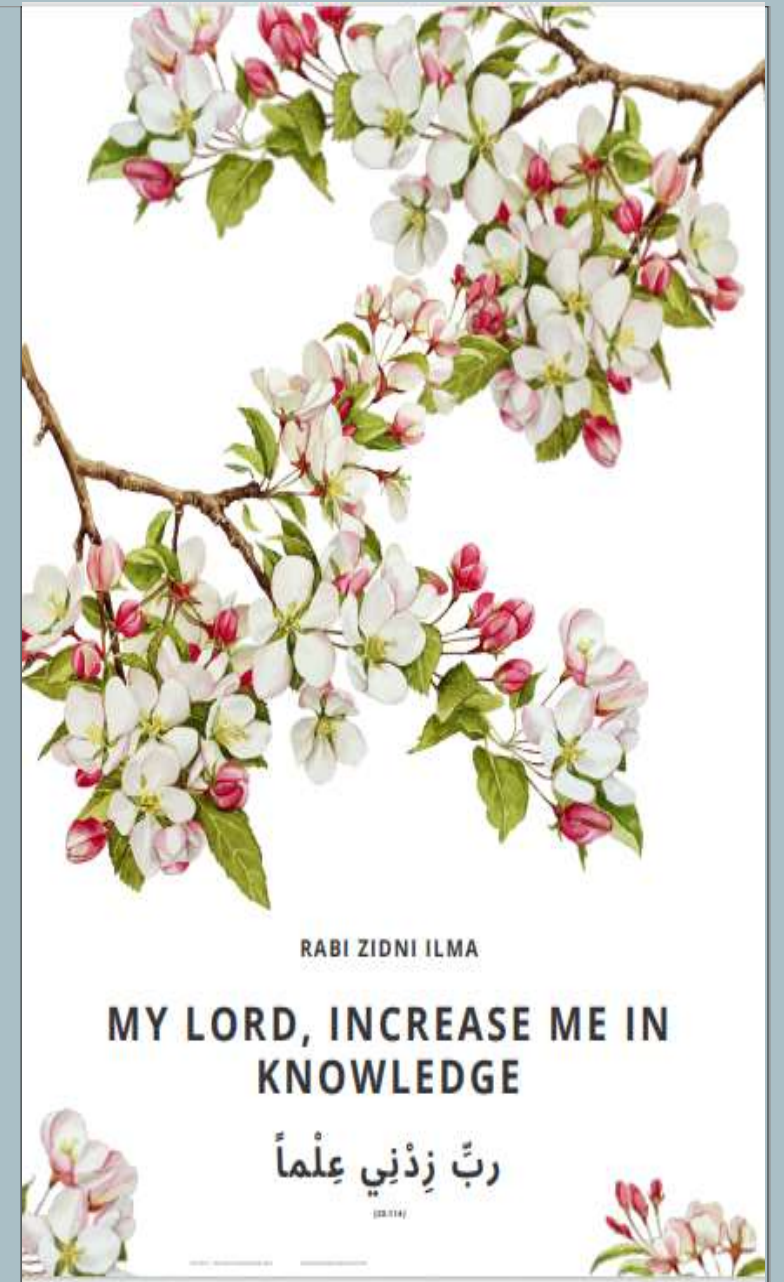

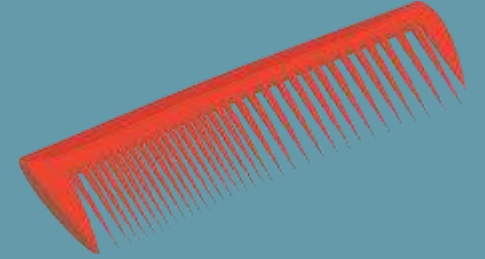

A is for Allah by Yusuf Islam

ا is for Allah, nothing but Allah.

ب is the beginning of Basmillah.

ت is for Taqwa, righteousness.

And ث is for Thawab, a reward.

ج is for Jannah, the Garden of Paradise.

ح is for Hajj, the blessed pilgrimage.

خ is for Khaalam, the seal of the prophethood given to the Prophet, Muhammad (SAW).

د is for Deen, Al-Islam, religion with Allah since time began.

ذ is for dhikr, remembering Allah.

And ر is for the month of Ramadhan, orh Ramadhan.

ز is for Zakat to cure our greed, when we give our money to those in need.

س is for Salaamu alaykum, peace be with you, wa alaykum wa salaam.

ش is for shams, the shining sun, which Allah placed for everyone.

And ص is for salaat, for when we pray facing him, every day, facing him, till we meet our Lord.

هـ is for the Hija, the journey that, the Prophet made.

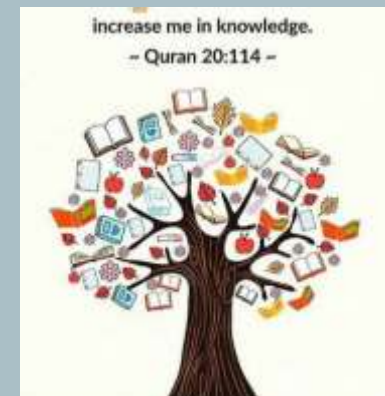
And و for wudu before we pray to help us wash our sins away.
