

English

For English Year 1 & 2 will be looking at the Minpins by Roald Dahl. The children will begin by engaging in the themes of the story by talking about danger and what they are allowed and not allowed to do, imagining gruesome consequences if they don't follow instructions! They then go on to read and explore The Minpins and create character descriptions (for their own monsters and the Minpins themselves). Retellings of the key events, reports about The Minpins and eventually writing a new chapter. Children will be able to link to their Islamic values on listening and respecting elders within their homes and school.

P.E.

This half term children are going to learn throwing and catching. They will warm their bodies up before exercising and cool down after exercising. They will roll a ball on a line to target with speed and control, then track it and stop it with two hands. Importance of looking after your health in Islam; impact it has on Ibadah.

Autumn Term Curriculum Overview

Islamic knowledge is incorporated into the curriculum

Maths

- Addition and subtraction of one and two digit numbers.
- Fact families - the 8 facts
- Recognise and name 2-D & 3-D shapes
- Patterns with 2-D & 3-D shapes
- Count money - pence & pounds (coins and notes) - Importance of Halal earnings.
- Make arrays - where children **arrange objects, numbers or pictures in columns or rows**. This helps children to understand multiplication and division.

Science

Year 1 & 2 will be focusing on growth and survival. They will learn and discuss about the life cycles of animals including humans, what they need to order to grow, thrive and survive. They will also be focusing on how diet, exercise and rest are important for the health of humans.

History

Children will learn about how and why bonfire night is celebrated. They will also think about use of fireworks at other occasions and its impact on the environment. They will explore what life was like at the end of Tudor period and how King James VI of Scotland became king of England. Children will also discuss / debate the decision taken by Guy Fawkes and its everlasting impact on people in England. They will think about their own decision's impact on their deen, duniya and akhira.

Art

We will learn about the importance of fire engines and the bravery of fire fighters. Children are to design, build and evaluate a model of a fire engine. They will learn duaa for safety from fire.

PSHE

Children will recognise and express feelings and emotions through body language. They will also explore different ways to manage and interpret feelings. Importance of Zikru-Allah for mental wellbeing with the 99 Names of Allah & Quran.
