

Yrs. 3&4 - English HW – W2 – Summer 1

Whilst reading 'Gulliver' we've been exploring ships log books in detail and you should now know a ship's log is an official record of important events in the management, operation and navigation of a ship. This also included the weather conditions and possible effects they may have on the crew's voyage.

Your homework this weekend is to keep a log of the weather conditions in your area, summarising how you and your family will be affected by the heat or cold, the rain or dryness, the wind or stillness of the air.

Imagine your home is your ship, and your family/guardians are your crew.

Will the weather conditions be enjoyable for your crew? Or will the weather change or ruin their plans. The conditions may affect your plans to play outside (in the garden/park), go shopping, take a walk, have a BBQ, wash the car, have guests come over or your ability to visit people over the weekend.

Your task is to write four **Logbook** entries. Observe the weather two times a day, **morning** and **evening** and record what you see, hear, smell, and what you may be able to feel, and how the weather will affect your family over the weekend.

Use Friday morning's log entry as an example to model your writing:

Friday - Morning.

I can feel the cold air whooshing in every time someone opens the doors, looking out the window I see grey clouds slowly forming in the distance, it looks like it might rain soon. Unlike yesterday there are no beams of sunshine in sight.
