Literacy

The children have been learning about Africa and all the different things you would see around Africa.

Ask your child what have they learnt about Africa?

What types of animals live there?

What fruits grow there?

What is the weather like there?

In your child's homework book get them to draw a picture of their thing they learnt about Africa, it could be a fruit or an animal. Ask your child to talk about their picture what they have drawn and write what they say to you underneath their picture.

Maths

Your child has been working on number recognition and number order - counting forwards from 1-6. For homework inform your child that they will be stacking pancakes. You will need a few items to make your paper pancakes.

You will need:

- Scissors
- Paper
- pen/board marker
- Spatula/ladle
- Toy/plastic plate

Method:

1. Draw and cut out six circles
2. With a pen or board marker write down numbers 1-6 on each circle.
3. Ask your child to find pancake number 1
4. Get them to lift the pancake with the spatula and place it on the plate.



5. Find pancake number 2 and continue adding the pancakes in order to number 6.

Challenge: Now reverse the game - taking off the pancakes and counting backward.
