



Half Term Curriculum Overview

Spring 1 2022

Topic: Sea & Coasts

Mathematics

Year 1 and 2 for Maths will be learning about multiplication and division. Children will learn to read, write, and understand mathematical ideas using multiplication (\times), division (\div), and equals ($=$) signs. They will start to use arrays and will use grouping to divide. Children will be using objects that help your child to understand adding objects that are groups in 2s, 5s, and 10s. Children will also use arrays to help them with multiplication.

PE

We will practice our Football skills:

- Warm up
- Passing
- Dribbling
- Team Building
- Positions
- Co-ordination

English

In spring 1 year 1 and 2 will be reading and discussing the book called 'Ocean Meets Sky' by the Fan Brothers. The book highlights and illustrates throughout the themes of family, memory, and loss. During these weeks working alongside the book, children will be given variety of meaningful writing opportunities throughout the sequence and gradually build up the skills to write an extended fantasy story of their own.

Islamic Link: For English, the books highlight about feelings and bereavements. We will be linking our English lesson to Prophet Muhammad PBUH who had also lost people within his family such as his parents and children and grandfather just like the individual in the book. Also raising the rank of a parent by leaving a positive and strong legacy for them.

ART

We will be discussing about seascape and coasts and will be producing creative work, exploring their ideas, and recording their experiences. Children will be using a range of materials creatively to design and make products. To also draw, paint and sculpture to develop and share their ideas. For our Islamic link, we will be looking at Islamic calligraphy and paintings painted by Muslims paints and how they have used such colours to bring out certain contrasts on certain images.

Science

In Science we will discuss about Seasonal changes and how seasons change over time. Children will be also discussing about the other types of weather they know and how weather is normally like during different seasons and learnt the length of day and night.

Geography

For Geography we will name and locate the five oceans and seven continents on the world map. We will discuss about how Allah has created the world with a simple instruction and appointed different people and animals in different locations around the world.

PSHE

For PSHE, year 1 and 2 will be looking at making decisions. Children will reflect on the various prophets from the past and how they have come across different scenarios such as prophet Moses and Prophet Yunus who came across various issues and how they overcome these issues effectively and positively simply because of the way they made their decision.
