Dad laughed and told us to be patient. As the tide started to go out we began to explore the rock pools. They were full of tiny fish and crabs.

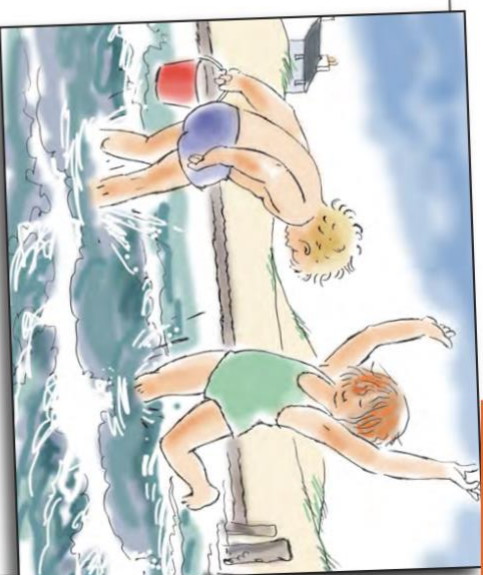
"I think you might need these," said Dad as he passed us some fishing nets.
