This week, we have introduced our new word of the week, please practice spelling out the word a few times and writing down the definition.

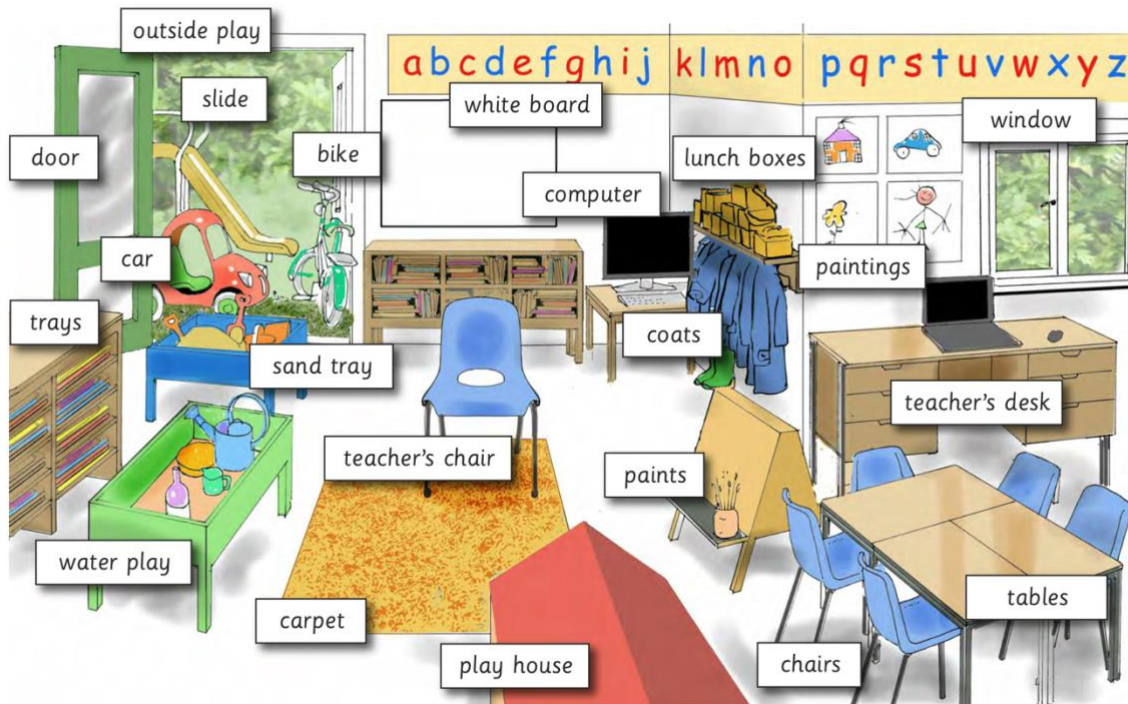
