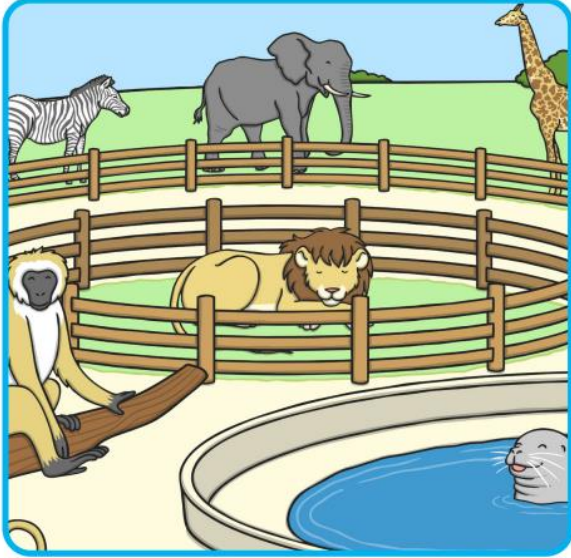
To help you understand what we have been learning this week I would like you to complete the following questions into your homework book.

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# How to Wrap a Present

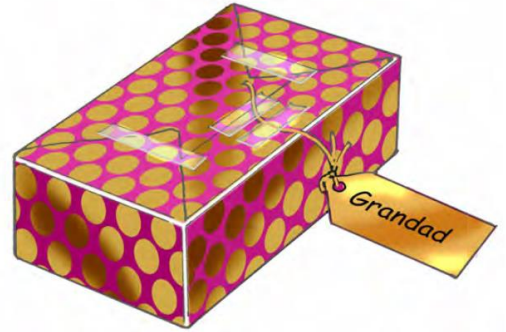
## Section A - Circle the correct answer.
